activity. The condition has affected Kieron's physical development so is small for his age. He benefits greatly from regular physio under the lead of paediatric and neurological services.

Kieron can be particularly affected by normal childhood illness and contact with others who are poorly.

So his foster carers have to be mindful of this.

Kieron attends nursery where he loves to play with other children.

Lola

Lola, aged 2, moved to live with her brother at his foster carer's home when she was discharged from hospital. This was after a short spell in the hospital after a difficult birth. She is described by her foster carer's as a content, giggly little girl. She loves to be

tickled and has a fancy to all things sweet and yummy!

She enjoys outdoor activities and interactive groups such as soft play.

Similarly to her brother Lola has a rare genetic disorder which she suffers from to a greater extent

than Kieron with some complex physical development delay. However, with the right support she has been thriving in her foster care placement. With the right support.

Like her brother Lola is caring and affectionate.
